

Registration 2021-2022 PROGRAM OFFERINGS

3-year-old program Thursday and Friday

\$170.00 per month 9:00 AM - 11:30 AM

Our 3 year old program is appropriate for children ages 2.9 – 3.11. Our emphasis is on the development of social skills for children who will be embarking on their first school experience. In this program children bring a snack to school.

Mixed Age Program Monday – Friday

\$315.00 per month 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM

Our mixed age program is appropriate for children ages 3-5. Your child must be 3 by <u>September 1, 2021</u> to be eligible for this program. This classroom will use a play based approach to learning through center based curriculum. Children are also exposed to Handwriting Without Tears curriculum that is used in the Attleboro Public Schools. In this program children bring a snack to school.

Enrichment 4's Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday

\$275.00 per month 9:15 AM- 1:00 PM

Our Enrichment 4's program is appropriate for 4 and 5 year olds who are ready for a longer session. This program is a combination of play based curriculum and in house enrichment programming. Some of the enrichment will be taught by classroom teachers (i.e. cooking and art). Other enrichment will be taught by specialists we bring in to the program (i.e. martial arts, music and movement, yoga, drama). Children are also exposed to Reading Street and Handwriting Without Tears curriculum that is used in the Attleboro Public Schools. In this program children bring a snack and lunch to school.

Pre-K 1 Monday- Friday

\$365.00 per month 8:30 AM - 12:30 PM

Our Pre-K program is appropriate for 4 and 5 year olds who will be entering Kindergarten the following year, and for children who are eligible for Kindergarten but not ready to make that step. The curriculum is designed by our talented teaching team and is more academically focused than our other programs. Children in this program will also be exposed to Reading Street and Handwriting Without Tears curriculum that is used in the Attleboro Public Schools. In this program children bring a snack and lunch to school.

Pre-K 2 Monday- Thursday

\$325.00 per month 8:45 AM - 12:45 PM

Our Pre-K program is appropriate for 4 and 5 year olds who will be entering Kindergarten the following year, and for children who are eligible for Kindergarten but not ready to make that step. The curriculum is designed by our talented teaching team and is more academically focused than our other programs. Children in this program will also be exposed to Reading Street and Handwriting Without Tears curriculum that is used in the Attleboro Public Schools. In this program children bring a snack and lunch to school.

Tuition Discount

A second child in the family attending school in the same year as a sibling is eligible for a 10% discount. The discount is given on the lesser tuition.

Registration Fee

A non-refundable \$75.00 fee is due upon registration. This fee covers all members of the immediate family.

Early Registration

Registration is open for children currently enrolled in our program, their siblings, and children of church members beginning on 1/19/21. Beginning on Saturday, January 30th registration will be open to the general public. Registration forms will be completed via a Google form which will time stamp the entry. Children are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Once the entry is received you will get an email confirming your registration at which time the registration fee will be due. Registration fees must be paid within 7 days to secure your child's spot. This can be paid via check, credit card or online in the MyProcare portal.

Tuition Payments

A <u>non-refundable</u> registration fee is due at the time of registration. Tuition is paid in ten monthly installments. The first payment is due on August 1, 2021. The remaining nine payments are due September through May on the 10th of each month. *A late fee of \$10.00 will be assessed for payments not received on time.* Tuition is due regardless of child absences. A 30 day notice of withdrawal is required.

Late Pick Up Policy

Jack and Jill Pre-School has instituted a late pick up policy of \$1.00 a minute, per minute late. For example, if you are six minutes late to pick up your child, you owe a \$6.00 late pick up fee. Late pick up fees are to be paid within 24 hours of incident.

Class Size for 2021-2022

As we continue to navigate preschool in the midst of COVID we will be limiting our class sizes to ensure the health and safety of our staff, students, and families. This has the potential to change as 2021 progresses. When registration opens each class will have 10 spots available. After the 10 spots are filled we will start a wait list.

Enrollment Procedures

January 2021

Our annual OPEN HOUSE will be held virtually on Saturday January 30th. There will be a presentation of the school and the teachers will be present and available to talk with. Registration begins that day. Due to current physical distancing regulations we will open each class with 12 spots, after which time we will begin a waitlist. We do not know what September will bring in terms of health and safety guidelines but there is a possibility that we are able to increase each class size to 16.

June 2021

All enrolled students will be sent an enrollment packet to be completed and returned with their first tuition payment on or before August 1, 2021. Due to the current guidelines it is imperative that all paperwork and first month's tuition be received on or before August 1^{st.} Payment and paperwork that is not received by August 1st will result in your child's spot being offered to the first on the waitlist and your child moving to the bottom of the waitlist.

August 2021

All families will be sent a letter listing playground days to be held in August. Playground days are especially helpful for incoming students who will have a chance to meet some of their peers and interact with their teachers before the first day of school.

September 2021

<u>Orientation Day:</u> Orientation day is a special day for us all! This is a time when children meet their teachers and classmates. This year, parents will be asked to participate in a ZOOM Parent Orientation Session with the Director to discuss important aspects of our community. The orientation is designed to help ease first day of school jitters for parents and children alike.
